General Description:

This position is organizationally falls under the direct supervision of the Behavioral Health Director of the Kickapoo Tribal Health Center (KTHC) as operated by the Kickapoo Tribal of Oklahoma. Operational hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. or as needed to serve the health care needs. The purpose of this position is to perform the duties of a Grant Substance Abuse Provider and Therapist for the Kickapoo Behavioral Health Program. Direct client services will include individual and group therapy and interventions necessary to meet client goals toward recovery.

This position is a five (5) year Grant Position

Qualifications:

Education – A Masters Degree in Counseling Psychology or related field.

Experience – A Masters Degree, with at least two (2) years relevant experience in the treatment of mental health/substance abuse issues and experience with Federal Grants is preferred.

Licenses & Certification – Incumbent must have a license as a Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT), Licensed Alcohol/Drug Counselor (LADC), Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW), or Licensed Behavioral Practitioner (LBP)

Will be required to have an OSBI clearance
